

What is the I Intercultural Coexistence Plan?

The I Intercultural Coexistence Plan of Santa Lucía de Tirajana is an initiative whose main goal is to design a Plan of action for all the departments of the City Council, using a participatory approach. Its primary purpose is to promote diversity management, intercultural coexistence and preventing discrimination on an institutional and social level in our city.

Why do we want to develop this Plan?

This proposal arises from the need to create an environment where every local resident feels like a full citizen with the same rights as everyone else, no matter their origin, religion or culture.

How will the Plan be carried out?

The I Intercultural Coexistence Plan of Santa Lucía de Tirajana will be developed by following a process that involves the population, institutions and groups who want to participate. The phases of the Plan are the following:

PHASE 1: DIAGNOSIS. The current challenges and problems related to the intercultural coexistence will be analysed together with the population and the key agents.

PHASE 2: PARTICIPATORY DEFINITION OF THE PLAN. After analysing the current situation, the objectives and strategies to improve the intercultural coexistence will be detected.

PHASE 3: WRITING THE FINAL DOCUMENT AND RETURNING IT TO THE POPULATION. During this phase, the Plan will be conceived by taking into consideration the contributions from the community and it will be presented for its revision and approval. In addition, transparency and citizen participation during the process will be guaranteed.



Who can participate?

We want every citizen to have the opportunity to provide their knowledge, experiences and perspectives. Our main goal is to create a joint plan of action that reflects the needs and aspirations of our community.
